29 Red Rows 2012 _____ \$24

Silver Medal North Central Washington Wine Awards, 2015

As the story goes, it came from 29 rows!

Estate blend of Sangiovese, Merlot and Syrah vinified with a backbone of Willard Farms Cabernet Franc adding firm structure to this smooth medium-bodied garnet wine. Neutral oak in the winemaking lets the fruit of the 29 rows tingle with medium tannins.

Innfrared 2013 _____ \$22

Medium-oaked five grape red blend named for our "inncredible" Warm Springs Inn. Bursts of dried fruit flavors, baking spice and vanilla round out this garnet-hued wine. It's a pleasure to "innvite" you to drink. Medium-tannins, medium acidity and flavors of baked red fruits.

Clusterphobia 2014 _____ \$22

Bronze Medal North Central Washington Wine Awards, 2016

Seductive, deep ruby-hued body. With a spicy nose and earthy palate, this Merlot-focused red blend has just the right amount of juicy raspberry and dark cherry fruit flavors to balance the dusty, oak undertones. Drink without fear, feel free to consume immediately or let age for a year or two.

Sangiovese 2012 _____ \$38

Sangiovese-focused red blend of Brender Canyon Estate fruit balanced by Syrah & Willard Farms Cabernet Franc. Light-medium bodied with soft, fresh cherry flavors and a slight hint of warm baked vanilla. Easy-going acidity and gentle tannins. Syrah and Cabernet Franc add just a hint of earthiness on the palate.

Merlot 2012 _____ \$38

Gold Medal North Central Washington Wine Awards, 2016

Medium-bodied with hints of cherry, sun-dried plum and toned down vanilla. A pop of Cabernet Franc blended in to the Merlot adds a pleasing note of floral violet and earth.

Syrah 2012 _____ \$48

Gold Medal North Central Washington Wine Awards, 2015

Syrah is a shining star of Washington Wine Country. Medium-full bodied expressing juicy red fruit, floral notes and a spicy, vanilla undertone.
